Subject:	Wearing the patrol uniform off patrol

Dear All,

This memo serves to clarify the following for all members within the organisation:

When a member is off-duty, the patrol uniform shall **NOT** be worn. This includes patrol shirts, the shorts and the cap, as well as any other patrol uniform which is included in the SLSA Uniform Policy & Brand Guidelines e.g. (Jackets, peak-caps, rash-shirts etc).

SLSA Policy 5.1 states, *“Any items of the SLSA patrol uniform shall **ONLY** be worn while on patrol duty or when attending official surf lifesaving functions and community education activities such as media promotions of surf lifesaving.”*

Wearing the patrol uniform off-duty and in any way which brings the organisation into disrepute shall be investigated by Branch & State against the relevant rules/regulations.
